


"Original Proposed" Goals

Promotion and Celebration (CSG)

- Connect your faculty to Funding Agencies and external entities....
- Celebrate your Diverse Faculty connections with their professional organizations.... Never know what the contacts may yield (GEM conference)
- "Diversity owned technical businesses are rare!"
- Feature faculty for internal/external reports and presentations
- Awards: Local, National, International, Alumni
- Send faculty to "invitation-only" national special meetings (National Academy Faculty meetings.. Alumni list...)



- Sponsor trips to Funding Agencies; or have Program Managers come to your institution; "piggyback" on scheduled visits for one-on-one meetings and seminars
- Faculty "Public Relations"
 - Be equitable in announcements of awards and promotions
 - Hospitality suites at national conferences
- Faculty profiles: Websites → updates, coordination
- Alumni and current students; Newletters
- Awards: Local, National, International






