Activate your NinerNET account

It's your username and password to log into University systems and services. Keep them confidential! Visit **ninernet.uncc.edu.**

Sign up for Duo 2-factor authentication

While logged in at **ninernet.uncc.edu**, follow prompts in the Duo section. 2-factor authentication protects your NinerNET account by requiring two forms of verification instead of one. See FAQs at **go.uncc.edu/CBb7**.

Visit My UNC Charlotte

You can quickly access popular systems and resources–Gmail, Canvas, Banner, Connect, and more–all in one place: **my.uncc.edu**!

Manage your employee information

While logged in at **my.uncc.edu**, select the Banner Self Service icon at the top. From there, set up direct deposit, review leave balances, change contact information, and more.

Subscribe to emergency alerts

Make sure you're signed up to receive emergency alerts via text and email. Visit **emergency.uncc.edu/nineralerts**.
